The Boxing Act 2024

A BILL

To legalize and regulate the sport of boxing in Vindex Nation.

Be it enacted by the House of Representatives of the Republic of Vindex Nation in Congress assembled.

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the Boxing Act 2024.

SEC. 2. **DEFINITIONS.**

As used in this Act, the term—

A "boxing match" shall be defined as a fist fight between two, or more, consenting citizens.

An "EMS" shall be defined as a member of the Vindex Department of Health and Human Services who has the ability to revive a player that has been knocked unconscious.

A "Surgeon" shall be defined as a member of the Vindex Department of Health and Human Services who has the ability to operate on a player that is bleeding following a revival from an EMS.

"Private property" shall be defined as an in-game 'area shop' (AS) region owned by someone not on behalf of the government.

SEC. 3. BOXING MATCHES.

(1) A citizen may participate in a boxing match with another citizen, so long as both parties consent.

SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

- (1) For a boxing match to be legal, an EMS and Surgeon must be online throughout the entirety of the boxing match and give a verbal agreement to revive, and operate on, any participating party in the likely event they are knocked unconscious. Such an agreement must be reached prior to the boxing match.
- (2) Fights where citizens are knocked unconscious that involved the use of a weapon, or failed to gain the consent of an EMS and Surgeon, are not considered legal and neither party is protected from prosecution.
- (3) No party is protected from prosecution in the event a participant did not consent.
- (4) For a boxing match to be legal, it must only occur on private property with the consent of the owner. Certain boxing matches may be legal in public or on government property only with the authorization of the President of Vindex Nation.
